LIPA blackouts: Jim Bileci spoke to Assemblyman Andrew Raia's office regarding the excessive number of electrical blackouts we experience at Crabmeadow. He was advised that we have indeed experienced abnormally high outages and that LIPA has acknowledged that this is caused by an overloaded system. To this end, they are in the process of transferring us from the Elwood sub-station to the Pulaski sub-station and are also in the process of installing a larger transformer for the Crabmeadow area. LIPA has assured Raia's office that the outages will end in July. - Thanks Jim for letting us know (but keep those flashlights handy just in case ☺).
